UP Unseats West Bengal as India's Top Vegetable Producer; Andhra Pradesh Retains Its Lead in Fruits

Uttar Pradesh (UP) has become the top producer of vegetables, getting back its first position

by demoting West Bengal to the second position, with a difference of a million tonnes(mt) in production in 2021–22 Crop Year (CY) (July–June), after two years since 2020. On the other hand, **Andhra Pradesh** remains the top fruit producer.

- India's horticulture output is likely to drop marginally by 0.4% to 333.25mt in 2021–22 from the previous year (2020–21) as production of vegetables, spices, and plantation crops is set to decline.

Vegetable Production:

i.Vegetable production in Uttar Pradesh is expected to be 29.58 million tonnes (mt) in the 2021–22 crop year (July–June), down from 29.16 mt in 2020–21, while West Bengal output is expected to dip to 28.23 mt in 2021-22 from 30.33 mt in 2020-21.

ii.Other top producers of vegetables as per the data in the current year 2021-22 include Madhya Pradesh at 20.59 mt, Bihar at 17.77 mt and Maharashtra at 16.78 mt.

Fruit Production:

i.In 2021–22, Andhra Pradesh is expected to produce 18.01 million tonnes of fruit, up from 17.7 million tonnes in 2020–21.

ii.Maharashtra is anticipated to produce 12.3 million tonnes of fruit, up from 11.74 million tonnes in 2020–21.

Measures by The Government of India (GoI) To Leverage the Horticulture Production: Mission for Integrated Development of

Horticulture (MIDH) scheme:

- It is a centrally sponsored scheme (CSS) implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare (MoA&FW) from 2014-15.
- It is launched with an objective to have holistic growth of the horticulture sector covering fruits, vegetables, root and tuber crops, mushroom, spices, flowers, aromatic plants, coconut, cashew and cocoa.

CJI, NV Ramana Launches 'FASTER' Program for Transmitting Judicial Orders

The Chief Justice of India (CJI), NV

Ramana virtually

launched the '**Fast and Secured Transmission**



of Electronic Records' (FASTER) programme. It is a digital platform to communicate interim orders, stay orders, bail orders etc., of the Supreme Court to authorities concerned through a secured electronic communication channel.

- It allows court orders to be transmitted in a quick and secure electronic format.

Objective-

To eliminate the situation in which inmates' release is delayed even after the Supreme Court grants them bail.

About 'Fast and Secured Transmission of Electronic Records' (FASTER) programme:

i.The FASTER program was created in response to a news report published in July 2021, regarding prisoner release delays.

ii.It is developed on war footing by the Registry in collaboration with the National Informatics Centre (NIC).

iii.All nodal officers have been connected through a specific Judicial Communication Network (JCN) by creating a secured pathway.

HDFC Ltd to merge with HDFC Bank by FY24

The board of directors of the Housing Development Finance Corporation (HDFC) Limited at its meeting held has approved the amalgamation of HDFC Investments Limited and HDFC Holdings Limited with HDFC Ltd, and HDFC Ltd with HDFC Bank. Subsequently, HDFC will merge with its banking arm, resulting in all the group companies becoming direct subsidiaries of HDFC Bank. Besides the bank, HDFC is the holding company for HDFC Life, HDFC General Insurance, HDFC Mutual Fund, HDFC Credila and HDFC Venture Capital. This amalgamation deal valued at \$40 billion.

Note- HDFC Investments Limited and HDFC Holdings Limited are the wholly acquired subsidiaries of HDFC Bank Limited.

Highlights:

i.Shareholders of HDFC Ltd as on the record date will receive 42 shares of HDFC Bank (each of face value of ₹1), for 25 shares held in HDFC Ltd (each of face value of ₹2). The equity share(s) held by HDFC Ltd in HDFC Bank will be extinguished as per the scheme.

ii.After the merging, the HDFC Bank will be 100 percent owned by public shareholders and existing shareholders of HDFC Ltd will own 41 per cent of HDFC Bank through the transformational merger.

iii.The merger will enable HDFC Bank to build its housing loan portfolio and increase its customer base. The merger is expected to be completed by FY(Financial Year)-24.

Tesla CEO Elon Musk Acquires 9.2% Stake in Twitter

According to the United States' Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Schedule, 13G filing on 14th March 2022, Elon Musk, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Tesla Inc., has purchased a 9.2% stake in Twitter Inc.

This purchase has made Elon Musk the largest shareholder of Twitter, with more than four times the 2.25% holding of Twitter founder Jack Dorsey.

Key Points:

i. The 9.2% stake amounts to nearly 73 million shares, worth around ~USD 2.89 billion. He owns 73,486,938 shares of common stock in his personal capacity.

ii. The disclosure of this acquisition led to a 27% rise in Twitter share price in pre-market trading.

Note: As per a 2018 SEC ruling, Musk has to get his tweets pre-approved to protect investors.

CMIE: Chhattisgarh tops states with lowest unemployment rate in country

According to the latest data (5 April 2022) released by the Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE), **Chhattisgarh** has been ranked first among states with the lowest unemployment rate of **0.6 percent** in the country.

- The overall **Unemployment rate in India** has decreased to **7.6 percent** (March 2022) from 8.10 percent in February 2022.
- As per the data, Haryana has the highest unemployment rate at 26.7 per cent.

Reasons for Decline:

i. The Chhattisgarh government had adopted a new model of development on lines of Mahatma Gandhi's vision of 'Gram Swaraj' envisaging inclusive development of the state and launched various schemes including Suraji Gaon Yojana, Narva-Garva-Ghurva-Bari programme, Godhan Nyay Yojana, Rajiv Gandhi Kisan Nyay Yojana etc. for boosting the rural economy.

ii. The state government has also set up the 'Chhattisgarh Employment Mission' intending to create around 15 lakh new employment opportunities in the next five years.

Union Cabinet approves Indian Antarctica Bill

The Union Cabinet has approved the draft

legislation, **Indian Antarctica Bill**, to provide a regulatory framework for India's research activities in



Antarctica and protect the environment in the icy continent. The bill piloted by the Ministry of Earth Sciences(MoES) will be introduced in the ongoing budget session of the Parliament.

The draft bill is the **first domestic legislation** with regard to Antarctica in India.

- The bill is expected to support India to fulfil its obligations under the Antarctic Treaty of

1959, the Convention on the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources of 1982 and the Protocol on Environmental Protection to the Antarctic Treaty of 1998.

- The Indian Antarctic programme started in 1981 and has completed 40 scientific expeditions and built three permanent research base stations (Dakshin Gangotri (1983), Maitri (1988) and Bharati (2012)) in Antarctica. Only Maitri and Bharati are fully operational.

QS World University Rankings by Subject 2022: IIT Bombay & IIT Delhi among top 100 under Engineering & Technology list

On 6th April 2022, QS Quacquarelli Symonds released the 12th edition of the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2022, the subject-wise rankings of institutes across the world are compilations of multiple lists.



- Indian Institute of Technology(IIT)-**Bombay** ranked **65th** and Indian Institute of Technology(IIT)- **Delhi** ranked **72nd**, are the only Indian institutes to be featured among the top 100 ranks under the Engineering and Technology category.
- IIT Bombay has scored 79.9 and IIT Delhi has scored 78.9.

Massachusetts Institute of Technology has topped the list with a score of 96.5 followed by the University of Cambridge and the University of Oxford.

President Ram Nath Kovind Gives Assent To Criminal Procedure (Identification) Bill & Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bill

President of India, Ram Nath Kovind gives assent to Criminal Procedure (Identification) Bill and the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bill. Here on, the bill will be termed as **Criminal Procedure (Identification) Act, 2022** and the **Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2022**.

Objective:

The objective of the Criminal Procedure (Identification) Act, 2022 is to authorise for taking measurements of **convicts** and other persons for the purposes of **identification** and investigation in **criminal matters** and to preserve records.

The Criminal Procedure (Identification) Act, 2022

The Criminal Procedure (Identification) Act, 2022 has replaced the **Identification of Prisoners Act, 1920**. Several modifications have been made to control the crimes happening in India.

The Delhi Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 2022

i. The Bill seeks to amend the Delhi Municipal

Corporation Act, 1957 passed by Parliament. Later the Act was amended in 2011 by Delhi Legislative Assembly to **trifurcate** the erstwhile Municipal Corporation of Delhi into,

- North Delhi Municipal Corporation (**NDMC**).
- South Delhi Municipal Corporation (**SDMC**).
- East Delhi Municipal Corporation (**EDMC**).

Asia's Largest Sewerage Treatment Plant At Okhla; Set To Play Major Role In Yamuna Cleaning Process

The Okhla Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP), with a capacity of 564 Million Litres Per Day (MLD), largest STP in Asia, which is set to function in Delhi from **December 2022** will play a major role in Yamuna river cleaning process. Following the completion of this project the water quality of river Yamuna will be improved.

- This STP aims to remove contaminants from sewage to produce an effluent that is suitable for discharge to the surrounding environment or an intended reuse application
- According to the Ministry of Jal Shakti, the total sanction cost of the Okhla STP project is **Rs 665.78 crore**.

PM Modi Inaugurates 'Pradhanmantri Sangrahalaya': Paytm Becomes Its Official Digital Payments Partner

Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi inaugurated the **Pradhanmantri Sangrahalaya**, or Prime Ministers' Museum, in New Delhi (Delhi), to honour the efforts of all 14 Indian Prime Ministers since independence, regardless of ideology or duration in office.



- Beginning with exhibits on the freedom struggle and the drafting of the Constitution,

the Sangrahalaya moves on to tell the tale of how our Prime Ministers guided the country through numerous challenges and secured the country's overall progress.

The inauguration took place as part of the ongoing Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations and to commemorate **Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar's 131st birth anniversary**.

About the Pradhanmantri Sangrahalaya/ Prime Ministers' Museum:

i. The museum, which is a tribute to former Prime Ministers of India, will be opened to the public on April 21, 2022. PM Modi also purchased the first ticket of the museum before its inauguration

- The museum is built at a cost of Rs. 271 crores.

ii. It is constructed on the site of **Teen Murti Estate**, which served as the home of India's first Prime Minister, Jawaharlal Nehru, for 16 years until being converted into the **Nehru Memorial Museum and Library (NMML)** following his death.

- The museum incorporates the former Teen Murti Bhavan, which is classified as Block I, and the newly constructed Block II. The two blocks have a combined area of more than 15,600 square metres. No trees were felled or transplanted during the course of work on the project.

iii. The logo of the Sangrahalaya depicts the hands of the people of India holding the Dharma Chakra symbolizing the nation and democracy.

- There are 43 galleries in the facility, as well as exhibits on the freedom struggle and the framing of the Indian Constitution.

iv. The Sangrahalaya has employed cutting-edge technology-based interfaces to provide diversity in content and frequent rotation of the display.

- Holograms, virtual reality, augmented reality, multi-touch, multimedia, interactive

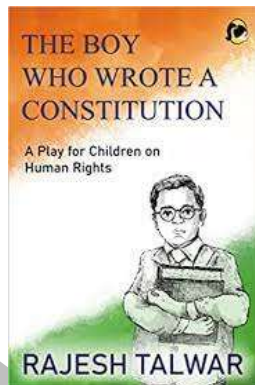
kiosks, computerised kinetic sculptures, smartphone applications, interactive screens, experiential installations, and other technologies make the exhibition content more dynamic and engaging.

v. Paytm has become an official digital payments partner for the prime ministers' museum.

- It is offering its payment gateway, EDC (Electronic Data Capture) machines and QR code payment options to make way for superfast, convenient and secure transactions.

New Children's Book "The Boy Who Wrote a Constitution" has been Released

On April 14, 2022, during the occasion of Dr. BR Ambedkar's 131st birth anniversary, a new book titled "The Boy Who Wrote a Constitution: A play for Children on Human Rights" authored by Rajesh Talwar, a fact-based drama on Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar's own recollections of his childhood has been released.



- It is published by Ponytale Books.
- This book conveys the children about the challenging boyhood and grown-up years of Ambedkar who had written the Constitution of India and became the India's first law minister.
- Talwar's also authored books include "The Vanishing of Subhash Bose", "Gandhi, Ambedkar, and the Four-Legged Scorpion", and "Aurangzeb".

India to Get World's Highest Tunnel at Shinku La Pass

India is set to have the world's highest tunnel at **Shinku La Pass**, between Zaskar Valley in Ladakh and Lahaul Valley in Himachal Pradesh.



The tunnel is set to be built by the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) at an altitude of **16,580 feet** above sea level. Length of the Shinku La tunnel – 4.25 km.

Details of the tunnel:

- The BRO will start the construction of the record-breaking tunnel connecting Himachal Pradesh to the Union Territory (UT) of Ladakh by July 2022.
- The centre has constituted a BRO team "Project Yojak" to execute the project.
- The tunnel is expected to be operational for vehicles by 2025.
- The Shinku La Pass will host the south portal of the tunnel and the north portal will provide access to motorists to enter Lakhang and the Zaskar Valley.
- The tunnel will reduce the travel time from Himachal Pradesh to Ladakh.

Note:

As of now, the highest tunnels are located in China and Peru, both not exceeding 16000 feet above sea level.

Shivamogga Airport To Be Named After BS Yediyurappa: Karnataka Former CM

On April 20, 2022, The Karnataka State Cabinet headed by Chief Minister (CM) Basavaraj Bommai, gave nod to name the under-



construction **Shivamogga airport** after the former CM **Bookanakere Siddalingappa Yediyurappa**, the proposal will now be sent to the Union Civil Aviation Ministry for further clearance.

- Shivamogga airport is being constructed at Sogane on the outskirts of Bengaluru. The estimated cost of airport construction is Rs 384 crore.

Key Points:

- The construction of Shivamogga Airport was begun in 2020 under UDAN (Ude Desh Ka Aam Naagrik) Scheme by the efforts of the Former CM B S Yediyurappa.
- The Airport will be ready for inauguration by December 2022, which consists of the second longest runway in state measuring 3299 metres, the First being the Kempegowda International Airport Bengaluru, Karnataka with 4000 metres.
- Earlier, a list of names had been suggested for the airport, which includes rulers like Keladi Shivappa Nayaka, Keladi Chennamma and Mayuravarma, and Akka Mahadevi 12th century social reformer, Dr B R Ambedkar father of Indian Constitution and Kuvempu the national poet.

OIL commissioned India's First Pure Green Hydrogen Plant in Jorhat, Assam

Oil India Limited (OIL), India's second-largest hydrocarbon

explorer and producer, has inaugurated "India's first 99.999 % pure" Green

Hydrogen Pilot Plant in Assam, marking the country's first significant step toward a green hydrogen economy.



- The first plant of its sort in India, has an installed capacity of 10 kg hydrogen per day and was commissioned in a record time of 3 months at **Jorhat** pump station in Assam.

Sushil Chandra Mishra, Chairman & Managing Director, inaugurated the plant in the presence of Harish Madhav, Director (Finance) and Prasanta Borkakoty, Resident Chief Executive of OIL.

Significance of Green Hydrogen:

Green hydrogen is a term used to describe hydrogen gas that is produced using renewable energy such as wind or solar power and does not emit greenhouse gases.

- It can be utilised as a fuel in transportation, power generation, and industrial processes because it does not emit carbon dioxide when burned.

Hydrogen gas combines with oxygen to produce electricity and water vapour, making it a potential clean alternative to fossil fuels in a fuel cell that turns chemical energy into electricity.

Key Points:

- The plant is also the first in India to utilise the **Anion**

Exchange Membrane (AEM) technology.

Green hydrogen will be produced from the electricity generated by the existing 500 kW (kilowatt) Solar plant using a 100 kW AEM Electrolyser array.

ii. In the future, this plant is expected to boost its green hydrogen production from 10 kg per day to 30 kg per day.

iii. OIL has undertaken a detailed study on combining green hydrogen with natural gas for commercial purposes in partnership with the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT)-Guwahati, Assam.

PM Modi Released Commemorative Coin & Postage Stamp on 400th Birth Anniversary 9th Sikh Guru Tegh Bahadur

On 21st April 2022, Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi released a commemorative coin and postage stamp to mark the 400th birth anniversary of 9th Sikh Guru Tegh Bahadur. He also addressed the nation on the occasion of the 400th Parkash Purab celebrations at Red Fort, Delhi and remembered the sacrifice of Guru “Guru Tegh Bahadur” who stood against Aurangzeb’s tyranny to protect the dignity of their culture.

- He was popularly known as ‘Hind di Chaddar’, Jagat Guru. He was born in Amritsar and breathed his last in Delhi. He was the youngest son of Sri Guru Hargobind Ji.
- The programme shall be organized by the Ministry of Culture in collaboration with the Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee (DSGMC).

PM Modi Inaugurates 500 KW Solar Power Plant in Palli; Palli becomes India’s 1st Carbon-Neutral Panchayat

Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi inaugurated the **500 KW solar**

power plant at Palli

Village in Samba

District, Jammu and

Kashmir (J&K), during



his visit to Palli Gram Panchayat on the occasion of 13th National Panchayati Raj Day (24th April 2022).

With this inauguration, **Palli becomes India’s first carbon-neutral Panchayat.**

About the 500 KW solar power plant:

- The project was completed at a cost of **Rs 2.75 crore** and it was installed in a record time of around 2-3 weeks.
- The electricity generated by the plant will be distributed to the village which has a daily demand of 2,000 units.
- The 1500 solar panels placed across an area of 6,408 square meters will provide clean electricity to around 340 houses in the model panchayat under the ‘Gram Urja Swaraj’ programme.

Other initiatives:

i. PM Modi has laid the foundation stones for the **850 MW Ratle Hydroelectric Project** and **540 MW Kwar Hydroelectric project** which will be constructed on the Chenab river in Kishtwar District. These projects will ensure to meet the power requirements of the region.

- The 850 MW Ratle Hydroelectric Project will be constructed at a cost of around Rs 5,300 crore and the 540 MW Kwar Hydroelectric project will be built at a cost of around Rs 4500 crore.

ii. He also inaugurated the **8.45 Km Banihal-Qazigund Road Tunnel** built at a cost of over Rs 3100 crores. The tunnel reduces the road distance

between Banihal and Qazigund by 16 km, and the journey time by around 1 and half hours.

iii. He also laid the foundation stone of the **Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway**, which is being built at a cost of over Rs 7500 crore.

iv. He also dedicated **108 Jan Aushadhi Kendras** to the people of Jammu and Kashmir with an objective to provide quality medicines and surgical items to all at affordable prices.

- 51 of the 108 Kendras under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (**PMBJP**) are established in Jammu, while 57 are in Kashmir.

v. The PM has also launched the 'Amrit Sarovar Mission' and transferred the amount of the National Panchayat Award into the bank accounts of the winning Panchayats, in Samba, J&K.

Jamtara Becomes Country's First District With Library in Every Village

Jamtara in Jharkhand has become the first district in the country to have community libraries in all gram panchayats. The district has a total population of about eight lakh has a total of 118 gram panchayats under six blocks and each panchayat has a well-equipped library which is open for students from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Career counselling sessions and motivational classes are also held free of cost here. Derelict buildings were converted into libraries, funds received from Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and under the 14th and 15th Finance Commission.



- On November 13, 2020 the first district library was set up, with the assistance of

Deputy Commissioner **Faiz Aq Ahmed Mumtaz**.

India's first 'Amrit Sarovar' Completed in UP's Rampur

India's first 'Amrit Sarovar' has been completed in Shahabad's Patwai area of Rampur in Uttar Pradesh (UP).

The initiative focuses on the need for water conservation.



- As a part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' (75 years of India's independence), the Prime Minister declared that each district should have 75 'Amrit Sarovars' or ponds.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi insisted the above initiative in his 88th monthly radio broadcast 'Mann ki Baat'.

About Amrit Sarovar:

Under the Amrit Sarovar initiative, 75 water bodies will be developed and rejuvenated in each district as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

Amrit Sarovar In Patwai:

i. In the UP's gram panchayat Patwai, a pond existed but was mired in dirt and neglect. With the help of local people, school children and coordinated efforts of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (**MGNREGA**) it has now been transformed and has built a retaining wall, boundary, food court, fountains and lighting.

ii. The cleaned and rejuvenated pond has become a big centre of tourism in the rural area.

iii. It also conserves water in need of the hour.

iv. The funds were raised from kshetra panchayat and gram panchayat.

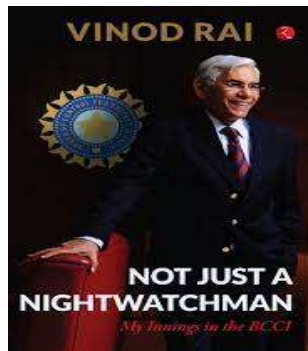

Central Govt amends FEMA (Non-debt Instruments) Rules, 2019 to Allow 20% FDI in LIC

In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (aa) and (ab) of sub-section (2) of section 46 of the Foreign Exchange



Management Act, 1999 (42 of 1999), the Central Government has amended Foreign Exchange Management (Non-debt Instruments) Rules, 2019 with **Foreign Exchange Management (Non-debt Instruments) (Amendment) Rules, 2022** allowing Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the **Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC)** upto 20%, and to align with the modified FDI policy.

- The amendment also allows start-ups to issue convertible notes for a maximum period of **10 years** from earlier 5 years.
- FEMA stands for Foreign Exchange Management Act.

Key Points:

- The Central Government is all set to dilute its 5% stake in LIC through the Initial Public Offering (IPO). In this regard, SEBI has also approved the draft prospectus for this stake sale for an estimated **Rs 63,000 crore**.
- On March 14, 2022, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) amended the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) policy to facilitate overseas investment in LIC.
- Foreign investment in LIC shall be subject to the provisions of the Life Insurance Corporation Act, 1956, (LIC Act) as amended from time to time and such provisions of the Insurance Act, 1938, as amended from time to time, as are applicable to LIC
- The LIC public issue is expected to be the biggest IPO in the history of the Indian stock market.

- So far, the amount from the IPO of Paytm in 2021 was the largest ever at **Rs 18,300 crore**, followed by Coal India (2010) at nearly Rs 15,500 crore and Reliance Power (2008) at Rs 11,700 crore.

Ecuador – first country to give legal rights to wild animals

The South American Country – Ecuador became the First country in the world to give legal rights to wild animals.

About Estrellita

case:-

i. Ana Beatriz

BurbanoProaño, a

librarian, Ecuador

took Estrellita a month old Woolly Monkey from the wild to grow it as her pet, Proano took care of Estrellita for about 18 years until the authorities seized her in 2019, as owning wild animals is illegal in South American country Ecuador.

ii. The authorities relocated the monkey to a Zoo but it died within a month because of the separation from the owner. Following which Proaño, the owner of the monkey filed a habeas corpus asking the court to rule that the monkey's rights were violated.

iii. The Judgement came in favour of Estrellita, the court acknowledged that the rights of the woolly monkey had been violated by the government and also added that the animal's rights were also violated by the owner when she removed the monkey from her natural habitat at a young age.

iv. The Court has finally stated that animals are subject to rights protected by rights of nature.

China unveiled the world's largest electric cruise ship "Yangtze River

Three Gorges

1" which costs around

(USD) 23.5 million.

The ship made its maiden voyage in Yichang, Hubei, China.



- The ship aims to promote and expand China's **marine electric vehicle market**, and to build a 'low carbon future' by promoting "Zero-emissions".
- Yangtze River Three Gorges 1 will be used for commercial purposes and for sightseeing trips in Yichang.

Yangtze River Three Gorges 1:

i. Yangtze River Three Gorges 1 was manufactured by **Yangtze power company** under China Three Gorges Corporation and the Hubei Yichang transportation group and supported by the Chinese government.

ii. The ship is equipped with Ningde Times batteries, with 15 independent battery packs adding up to around **7500** Kilowatt Hours (KWH) developed by world's No. 1 battery manufacturer for electric cars 'Contemporary Amperex Technology Co. Limited (CATL)'.

iii. As the ship is 100 metres long and 16 metres wide, it can carry about **1,300** passengers.

iv. The ship can travel upto 100 kilometres on a single charge. And the power to operate the ship comes from the **Three Gorges Dam**, Yichang, China.

Specifications Of Yangtze River Three Gorges 1:

i. The ship has an automatic control system and intelligent power management system.

ii. It has the world's first "**high-voltage + low-voltage**" charging scheme, and also it has Direct Current (DC)

grid distribution system, full rotary rudder system, large ship DC inverter central air-conditioning system.

AUKUS Defence Alliance Adds Hypersonic Weapons To Security Pact

The United States (US), United Kingdom (UK) and Australia created a security

pact and defence alliance known as **AUKUS** to develop **hypersonic missiles** and electronic warfare capabilities. The



leaders of AUKUS are British Prime Minister Boris Johnson, US President Joe Biden and Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison.

- In 2021 the **Indo-Pacific alliance** included the sharing of nuclear-powered **submarine** technology.

Trilateral Cooperation:

- The new trilateral cooperation includes information sharing and deepens cooperation on hypersonics weapons and counter-hypersonics weapons.
- The AUKUS also planned to develop conventionally armed submarines for Australia.
- It will also focus on cyber capabilities, artificial intelligence, quantum technologies and additional undersea capabilities.

Hypersonic Weapon Programme:

- The US and Australia have a hypersonic weapon programme called **SCIFiRE** (Southern Cross Integrated Flight Research Experiment). Also, the UK pretended to join SCIFiRE.
- The AUKUS planned to work together in the area of research and development.

- The US will invest **4.7 billion** United States Dollar (USD) in the research and development of hypersonic missiles.
- The US plans to have a hypersonic missile battery fielded by 2023, a sea-based missile by 2025 and an air-based cruise missile by 2027.
- Also Australia plans to spend **2.6 billion** USD to acquire long-range strike missiles for fighter jets and warships.

The United States's Hypersonic Missile Test:

The Defence Advanced Research Projects Agency (**DARPA**) of US, completed a free-flight test of an aircraft-launched hypersonic missile at a speed of more than **Mach 5** (3,800 miles per hour, or 6,100 kilometres per hour).

UNHRC suspends Russia from Human Rights Council; India abstains from vote

Russia was suspended from the UN Human Rights Council (**UNHRC**) after the 193 members of United Nation General Assembly (**UNGA**) voted to adopt a resolution moved by the United States of America (USA) due to the ongoing Russian-Ukraine conflict.



- The resolution titled 'Suspension of the rights of membership of the Russian Federation in the Human Rights Council' was adopted with 93 votes in favour, 24 against and 58 abstentions, including India (abstains because of "substance and process").
- With this, Russia became the second country and First P-5 country to have its membership rights stripped at the rights council, which was established in 2006 (Russia's current membership on the Council expires in December 2023).
- In 2011, Libya was the first country to get suspended by the assembly when the upheaval occurred in the North African country which brought down the

longtime leader Moammar Gadhafi.

India was led by Union Ministers of MoD and MEA.

iii.India-US announced the establish of a new Education and Skills Development Working Group to further strengthen cooperation in the field of education and skill development.

i.India and the US have signed a troika of foundational pacts for deep military cooperation viz.

- Logistics Exchange Memorandum of Agreement (LEMOA) in 2016

- Communications Compatibility and Security Agreement (COMCASA) in 2018

- Basic Exchange and Cooperation Agreement (BECA) in 2020

ii.India and the US conduct regular bilateral and multilateral exercises, including the MALABAR exercise with inclusion of Australia, the tri-service TIGER TRIUMPH exercise, the multilateral MILAN naval exercise, the bilateral YUDH ABHYAS and VAJRA PRAHAR Army exercises, the bilateral COPE India air exercise, and Indian participation in RED FLAG.

COVID-19 plunged 77 million into poverty in 2021: UN-DESA Report

In accordance with the **United Nations Department of Economic and Social**

Affairs (UN-DESA)

report, titled '2022

Financing for

Sustainable Development Report: Bridging the

Finance Divide', the COVID-19 plunged 77 million

more people into extreme poverty in 2021 and many

developing countries can't recover because of debt

repayments. Now, the Ukraine-Russia War has further impacted this situation.



- The report is a joint product of the **Inter-agency Task Force on Financing for Development**.
- The report is on financing to achieve UN development goals for 2030, including ending poverty, ensuring quality education for all young people and achieving gender equality.
- It was produced by the UN-DESA in collaboration with more than 60 international agencies, including the UN system and international financial institutions.

Key Points:

- i. 812 million people lived in extreme poverty i.e. on USD 1.90 a day or less in 2019, and by 2021 this number had risen to 889 million.
- ii. The poorest countries spent billions of dollars servicing their debts and faced much higher borrowing costs, preventing them from spending on improving education and health care, protecting the environment and reducing inequality.
- iii. 1.7 billion people are faced with spiking food, energy and fertilizer costs as a result of the war in Ukraine
- iv. GDP (Gross Domestic Product) per capita in 20% of developing countries will not return to pre-2019 levels by the end of 2023.

Elon Musk acquires Twitter for approx \$44 billion

Tesla co-founder and World's richest person (as of April 26, 2022) Elon Musk has acquired social networking service Twitter Inc. for approximately \$44 billion with shares valued at \$54.20. Now the company will be held privately.



- The all-cash deal for the same is expected to be completed later this year

Key Points:

- i. Elon Musk is the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of electric car maker Tesla Inc; and aerospace company SpaceX.
- ii. His wishlist for the acquired company include Edit button, Free speech, spam bots, and changes in algorithm.
- iii. Under this deal, he secured \$25.5 billion of debt and margin loan financing and will provide about \$21 billion in equity to fund the deal.

The exercise sets the stage for operational level understanding between the two navies, highlighting both nations' shared commitment to the global maritime commons' security, safety, and freedom.

RS-28 SARMAT: Russia tests World's 'Most Powerful' Nuclear-Capable Ballistic Missile

On April 20, 2022, Russia had test-launched a new nuclear-capable

Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) namely 'RS-28 Sarmat' for the 1st time from Plesetsk in northwest Russia and hit targets in the Kamchatka peninsula, nearly 6,000 km (3,700 miles) away.



- It is also called 'Satan 2'.
- It will replace the R-36M ICBM (SS-18 'Satan') in Russia's arsenal.
- The Sarmat ICBM has been developed at the Makeyev State Rocket Center (part of

Roscosmos) and is manufactured at the Krasnash enterprise.

Key Points:

- i. It is the most powerful missile with the longest range of destruction of targets in the world.
- ii. Weighing over 200 tonnes and able to transport multiple warheads, it can hit any target on Earth.
- iii. It is designed to elude anti-missile defence systems with a short initial boost phase.
- iv. Sarmat is a three-stage, liquid-fueled missile with a range of 18,000 km and a launch weight of 208.1 metric tons, to be exact. The missile is 35.3 meters long and 3 meters in diameter.

Gulzar Ahmed To Be The caretaker Prime Minister Of Pakistan

Pakistan's Prime Minister (PM) Imran Khan nominated former

Chief Justice of Pakistan, Gulzar Ahmed as caretaker Prime Minister. The decision to



nominate Caretaker PM is due to the resignation of Imran Khan, as he failed to prove the majority in the parliament and the Deputy Speaker dismissed the no-confidence motion and later the parliament was dissolved by the President. Ahmed was sworn in as the 27th chief justice of Pakistan in 2019 till 2022.

- Chief Justice of Pakistan (CJP) Umar Ata Bandial considered the legality of the current situation and issue a "reasonable order"

Harsh V Shringla to Be Chief Coordinator of G20 Summit 2023

Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla has been appointed as the Chief Coordinator of the G20

Summit, which will be hosted by India in 2023. His appointment is effective from May 01, 2022, and he will hold the post till December 2023.



- Shringla, who will step down as Foreign Secretary on April 30, 2022, will be

succeeded by Vinay Mohan Kwatra, who is the current ambassador of India to Nepal.

India will hold the Presidency of the G20 from 1 December 2022 to 30 November 2023 and will host the **G20 Leaders' Summit** for the **first time in 2023**.

- The G20 Summit 2023 will be India's largest international event in recent years, bringing together the five P5 (US, Russia, China, the United Kingdom, and France) representatives in India at the same time.

Note: This is a newly created role for organising the summit, which will include both substantive aspects as well as logistics. Union Minister of Commerce & Industry Piyush Goyal will remain the G20 sherpa.

About Harsh Vardhan Shringla:

i. Shringla, an IFS officer of the 1984 batch, has been serving as foreign secretary since January, 2020. He has also served as ambassador to the United States, Thailand, and Bangladesh.

ii. He played a key role in implementing India's Neighbourhood First policy into action by visiting Afghanistan, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, and Sri Lanka during COVID-19, reinforcing India's commitment to assisting its neighbours.

iii. He oversaw India's election as a non-permanent member of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), in which India received 184 of the 192 votes cast.

i. Shahbaz Sharif, was elected unopposed because his rival candidate Shah Mahmood Qureshi staged a walkout by announcing that his Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party will boycott the voting process.

ii. Shahbaz Sharif was the younger brother of former three time Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif (who was barred by the Supreme Court in 2017 from holding public office for his corruption charges) and also served as Chief Minister of Punjab Province thrice.

iii. Asif Ali Zardari, former President and Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP) co-chair had proposed Mian Mohammad Shehbaz Sharif name for the PM's position in a joint opposition meeting to replace Imran Khan.

iv. Following which a No-Confidence Motion was raised and removed Imran Khan from the office of Prime Minister, which makes Imran Khan becoming the First PM in Pakistan's history to get removed by No-Confidence motion.

v. Since Independence in 1947, Pakistan has struggled with political instability with multiple regime changes and military coups, and no PM has ever completed a full five-year term so far.

Emmanuel Macron Wins 2nd Term & Re-Elected as French President; Defeated Le Pen

The French President Emmanuel Jean-Michel Frédéric Macron belonging to La République En Marche! (The Republic On The Move) party got re-elected as the



French President after defeating his far-right rival Marine Le Pen in a runoff election (Second Round) held on April 24, 2022, making Macron the first French President to get re-elected in last 20 years, before which only two Presidents have been re-elected for the second term.

Key Points:

i. According to Ministry of Interior, the centrist candidate Emmanuel Macron secured ~ over **58 percent** of the vote as against Le Pen, the candidate of the far right National Rally Party (Rassemblement National or RN), received ~ over **41 percent** of the votes (the highest in her last three unsuccessful presidential bids).

ii. Macron has become the first French President to get re-elected in the last 20 years, since Jacques Chirac in 2002.

iii. François Mitterrand and Jacques Chirac were the only Presidents who have served 2 full terms.

About Emmanuel Macron:

i. In April 2016 he launched the movement En Marche ! and served as its leader until his victory in the 2017 presidential election.

ii. He has served as the Deputy General Secretary of the Presidency of France from 2012 to 2014.

iii. He has also served as the Minister for Economy, Industry and Digital Affairs from August 2014 to August 2016.

About French Presidential Election:

i. According to Article 7 of the Constitution of France, the election of the President of the Republic is conducted in two rounds by an uninominal majority.

ii. To be elected in the first round, a candidate must obtain an absolute majority of the votes cast. Failing this, the two candidates with the highest number of votes in the first round participate in the second.

iii. The results of the presidential election are announced by the Constitutional Council .

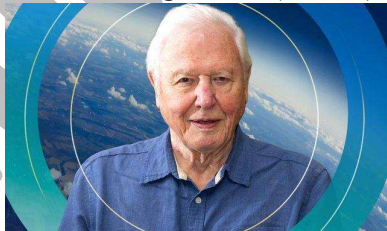

The 2021 Formula One(F1) World Champion **Max Verstappen**, a Belgian-Dutch racing driver and the Jamaican Olympic sprinter **Elaine Thompson-Herah** have won the World **Sportsman** of the year 2022 and Laureus World **Sportswoman** of the Year 2022 respectively.

- This marks Max Verstappen's first Laureus award and his 2nd nomination.

Host:

The 2022 Laureus World Sports Awards ceremony was hosted by Olympian **Lindsey Vonn**, the greatest women's skier of all time.

Gautam Adani Ranks 5 In Forbes' Real-time Billionaires List Overthrowing Warren Buffett

As of April 25 2022 ,Adani Group chairman **Gautam Adani** surpassed

Berkshire Hathaway chairman **Warren Buffett** to become the **fifth** richest person in the world, according to the 'Forbes' real-time billionaires list'.



The net worth of Gautam Adani is estimated to be United States Dollar (USD) **122.3** billion, where Buffett stands at USD 121.7 billion. The group has seven listed companies such as Adani Enterprises, Adani Ports, Adani Power, Adani Total Gas, Adani

Green Energy, Adani Transmission and Adani Wilmar.

- The returns have been multibagged from Adani Wilmar, by 235 percent, whereas Adani Power has zoomed 170 percent and Adani Green Energy has also gained 110 percent.

ii.The Atal Tunnel is the longest highway tunnel globally and connects Manali to Lahaul-Spiti valley throughout the year. Previously the valley was cut off for around 6 months due to heavy snow.

About IBC Awards for Excellence in Built Environment:

The IBC awards instituted in 1996 is an annual award which recognises the much-needed attention of society to the contributions being made by the professionals in the field of Built Environment.

Features of the tunnel:

i.The tunnel is equipped with a semi-transverse

ventilation system, where large fans separately circulate air throughout the tunnel.

ii. For evacuation during emergencies, an emergency tunnel has been integrated into the tunnel cross-section beneath the main carriageway.

iii. The tunnel is also equipped with fire hydrants at specific locations throughout the tunnel.

iv. The air quality in the tunnel will be continuously monitored using a pollution sensor and when the air quality lowers below the desired level, fresh air is injected into the tunnel through 2 heavy duty fans on either side.

i. **Jhulan Goswami** (Bowler) of India became the highest wicket-taker in the World Cup Tournament bagging overall of 43 wickets. **Indian bowler Jhulan Goswami** achieved this with 40 wickets in 31 matches, beating Australia's Lyn Fullston's 39 wickets in Women World cup tournaments.

ii. Indian women's team ODI skipper **Mithali Raj** broke the record for most matches captained (24 matches) in the ICC Women's World Cup.

Al Rihla is made of polyurethane (PU) skin featuring micro and macro textures and a new 20-piece panel shape enhances aerodynamics to improve the accuracy and field play.

- Being the first World Cup ball in the 92-year history, Al Rihla contributes 1% of the funds to the Common Goal movement.

La'eeb unveiled as official mascot for FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022

Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) has unveiled La'eeb as the official mascot for the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 during the draw for the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022, which took place in Doha, the capital of Qatar.



i. "La'eeb" – a super skilled player (in Arabic), is playful, adventurous and curious.

ii. According to FIFA and the Tournament organising body, The Supreme Committee for Delivery and

Legacy (SC), the mascot represents donning the flowing Qatari National dress and trying to stop the football in air.

iii. According to the Supreme Committee (SC), La'eeb comes from a parallel world where tournament mascots live. It is a world where ideas and creativity form the basis of characters that live in the minds of everyone.

iv. Also La'eeb encourages everyone to believe in themselves as 'Now is All'.

Note:

FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 is the first FIFA World Cup in the Middle East and also in the Arab World.

The Victoria State Of Australia To Host 2026 Commonwealth Games

Australia's **Victoria state** will be the host for 2026 Commonwealth Games (CWG). The 2026 Games will be held in four towns such as Geelong, Ballarat, Bendigo and Gippsland of Australia. The opening ceremony will be held at



Australia's largest cricket stadium – the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG). MCG can hold 100,000 spectators.

- So far Victoria state has announced **16 sports** for the 2026 Games, which includes aquatics, cycling and Twenty20 cricket.

Australia And Commonwealth Games (CWG):

i. Australia is hosting the CWG for the **sixth time** and the second time in Victoria, after Melbourne hosted the 2006 event.

ii. The 2026 Games are planned to be held outside the state capital Melbourne.

iii. CWG in Australia:

- **2018** – Commonwealth Games, Gold Coast, Queensland. The motto was “Friendly Games”.
- **2006** – Commonwealth Games, Melbourne, Victoria .
- **1982** – Commonwealth Games, Brisbane, Queensland.
- **1962** – British Empire and Commonwealth Games, Perth, Western Australia.
- **1938** – British Empire Games, Sydney, New South Wales.

iv. The CWG will not only uplift the life of the athletes but also boosts the Victoria state economy by 3 billion United States Dollar (USD).

Towns And Games:

- **Geelong** – a port city, will host swimming, gymnastics, beach volleyball and other sports.
- **Ballarat and Bendigo** – will host athletics, boxing, netball, squash and weightlifting.
- **Gippsland** – will host rugby sevens, badminton and cycling.

About Commonwealth Games (CWG):

- The CWG is held every four years.
- There are **72** nations and territories of the Commonwealth, almost all of whom are former territories of the British Empire.
- The four Home Nations of the United Kingdom (**England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland**) also send separate teams.

Birmingham will host the 2022 CWG from 28 July 2022 to 08 August 2022 under the motto ‘**Games for Everyone**’.

West Indies Cricketer Kieron Pollard Announced Retirement from International Cricket

On April 20, 2022, The West Indies cricketer and all-rounder, Kieron Adrian Pollard announced his retirement from his 15 year career in International Cricket. He hails from Tacarigua, Trinidad.



Highlights of his Cricket Career:

- Pollard, made his One Day International (ODI) debut in 2007 and became the first West Indies player in White-ball cricket to represent 101 Twenty 20 Internationals (T20Is) and 123 ODIs.
 - He was a key player of the West Indies team which won the International Cricket Council (ICC) T20 Cricket world cup in 2012 and only missed West Indies’ triumph at the 2016 tournament due to injury.
 - Pollard was appointed as captain for both ODI and T20 teams in 2019, with series wins over Australia and England.
 - Totally Pollard had scored 2706 runs and took 55 wickets in ODI cricket and 1569 runs at a strike rate of 135.14 in T20Is besides, picking 42 wickets at medium pace.
 - Lastly in March 2021, Pollard became the only third player in the history of the men’s international games to hit six sixes in a single over against Sri Lanka’s Akila Dananjaya, The other two players are Herschelle Gibbs and Yuvraj Singh (Later USA’s Jaskaran Malhotra joins the elite club on September 2021).
- Note:** Pollard never played Test Cricket.

Important Days with theme

World Health Day 2022 – April 7

World Health Day is annually observed across the globe on 7th April to bring attention to a specific topic of concern to people across the world.

World Health Day also marks the anniversary of the founding of the World Health



Organization (WHO) on 7th April 1948.

The theme of World Health Day 2022 is “Our Planet, Our Health”.

Background:

- i. The first World Health Assembly (WHA) decided that the WHO should sponsor the observance of World Health Day on 22nd July of every year.
- ii. Later, the 2nd World Health Assembly decided that starting from 1950, every year the 7th April will be observed as World Health Day.

38th Siachen Day – 13th April 2022

Siachen Day is annually observed by the Indian Army on 13th April, since 1984, to commemorate the Indian Army’s “Operation Meghdoot”. The day also honours the courage of the soldiers of the Indian Army who continue to guard the Siachen Glacier.



- 13th April 2022 marks the observance of the 38th Siachen Day.

Siachen Glacier, 76 kilometres long, one of the world’s longest mountain glaciers, lies in the Karakoram Range system of Kashmir near the India-Pakistan border.

Operation Meghdoot:

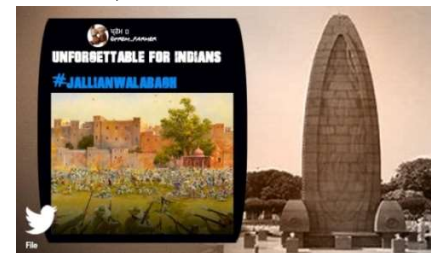
- i. Operation Meghdoot was the codename of the Indian Armed Forces’ operation to seize control of the Siachen Glacier in Kashmir and preempt Pakistan from occupying the Salto ridge and Siachen Glacier.
- ii. The operation was executed on 13th April 1984 on the highest battlefield in the world.
- iii. At present, the Indian Army remains the **first and only army** in the world to have taken tanks and other heavy ordnance up to such an altitude (well over 5,000 m or 16,000 ft).
- iv. The map of Siachen by mountaineering legend Colonel Narendra ‘Bull’ Kumar, played a major role in ensuring the success of Operation Meghdoot in 1984.

Note:

In 2003, Late Dr APJ Abdul Kalam became the first President and Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces to visit the troops deployed in ‘Operation Meghdoot.’

103rd Anniversary of JallianwalaBagh Massacre – 13th April 2022

13th April 2022 marks the 103rd anniversary of the JallianwalaBagh Massacre, which is also known as the Amritsar massacre, which took place on 13th April 1919. The commemoration of the anniversary of the JallianwalaBagh Massacre aims to pay homage to all the people who were martyred during the massacre.



JallianwalaBagh Massacre:

- i. On 13th April 1919, more than hundreds of people who were protesting peacefully against the Rowlatt Acts were gunned down by the British forces led by

British Indian Army officer Brigadier-General **Reginald Edward Harry Dyer (R E H Dyer)**.

ii. In October 1919, 7 member Disorders Inquiry Committee '**Hunter Committee**' headed by Lord William Hunter, a Senator of the College of Justice of Scotland was established to investigate the JallianwalaBagh Tragedy. Later Dyer was removed from the command into enforced retirement.

JallianwalaBagh:

i. JallianwalaBagh is a public garden located in Amritsar, Punjab. The garden houses the JallianwalaBagh National Memorial, a memorial of national importance, established in 1951 to commemorate the massacre.

ii. The memorial is managed by the **JallianwalaBagh National Memorial Trust**, chaired by the Prime Minister of India.

iii. People have also gathered at the JallianwalaBagh to protest against the arrest of two pro-independence leaders — Dr. Saifuddin Kitchlew and Dr. Satya Pal. Many other people were also at the venue to celebrate the festival of Baisakhi.

World Liver Day 2022 – 19th April

World Liver Day is annually observed across the globe on 19th April to create awareness about various liver-related diseases

and conditions and the importance of the liver which plays a vital role in the human digestive system.

The day also aims to motivate people to adopt a healthy lifestyle.

i. According to the World Health Organisation (WHO) report (2018), Liver diseases are the 10th most



common cause of death among Indians.

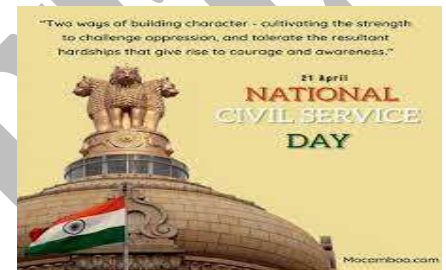
ii. The most common causes of liver-related deaths in India are Alcohol, Hepatotropic viruses and non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH).

ii. **22nd April** has been observed as Earth Day since 1970 by the EARTHDAY.ORG in more than 190 countries.

iii. The United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted the resolution A/RES/63/278 on 22nd April 2009 and proclaimed the 22nd April of every year as International Mother Earth Day.

13th National Panchayati Raj Day – 24th April 2022

National Panchayati Raj Day (NPRD) is annually observed across

India on **24th April** to celebrate the constitutional status accorded to the Panchayati

Raj system of India. The observance of the day is annually organised by the **Ministry of Panchayati Raj**.

24th April 2022 marks the celebration of the **13th National Panchayati Raj Day**.

Background:

The Ministry of Panchayati Raj annually

commemorates the 24th of April as the National Panchayati Raj Day (NPRD), which marks the historic day on which decentralization of power to the grassroots, with the institutionalization of Panchayati Raj, through the Constitution (73rd Amendment) Act, 1992 came into force.

- 73rd Constitutional Amendment came into force on **24th April 1993**.
- The **first** edition of National Panchayati Raj Day was observed on **24th April 2010**.

Event:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has visited Jammu & Kashmir (J&K) to participate in the celebration of NPRD. He visited Palli Panchayat in the Samba district and interacted with a local Panchayat representative.
